The Elementary School AED is located in the main lobby next to the gym door by the main entrance. Anyone using the AED should have received training in the use of this equipment, as using it incorrectly can potentially harm the user. An AED is used to help people experiencing sudden cardiac arrest. The AED gives step by step instructions to the person applying the device. The AED analyzes the heart rhythm of the person experiencing cardiac arrest and, if necessary, instructs the user to deliver an electrical shock to re-establish normal heart rhythm.

The high school has 3 Automatic Electronic Defibrillators (AEDs) on the grounds. One AED is in a case, and stored in the equipment side of the concession stand outside during the non-winter months, one is on the wall by the showcase in the HS lobby, and the other AED is on the wall outside of the main office door into the hall. The AED is a device that automatically reads the heart rhythm of a person, and it then tells the person applying the device what to do. An AED should only be used by a person trained to use it, due the potential harm to the user if procedure is not followed correctly. The AED does not give electrical shocks automatically, it only analyzes the rhythm and instructs the user what to do.
