Dear Parents/Guardians,

As winter quickly approaches, we are preparing for both Virtual Learning Days and Snow Days. If you receive notification via a text, call, or email or if you see a message on television that states **VIRTUAL LEARNING**, we will follow our Virtual Learning Schedule for Students. We may use up to five (5) days for such weather-related days.

Please know that attendance will be counted on virtual learning days. Your student will be marked as present for the Virtual Learning Day if he/she does the following:

- For each class that the student has, he/she must join in the live instruction with his/her teachers through a Google Meet. Please note that this must be done for each class period of the day.
- For each class that the student has he/she must complete an assigned activity on the teacher's Google Classroom page on the designated virtual learning day. The activity should be completed by the next school day. However, the student will have three days to complete the assigned activity for credit.

Please be aware that as we continue through the second marking period, after-school homework help is available on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:30 - 5:30 PM. Students have the opportunity to ride shuttle busses on these days.

If you receive notification via a text, call, or email or if you see a message on television that states **SNOW DAY, there will be no school work required.** That day will be made up. We will follow the school calendar, which lists 6/1, 6/2, 6/3, 1/17 and 4/14 as snow make up days. All other days will be added starting 6/6/22.
